

## HOW DO I APPLY?

Applications are accepted on a first come, first served basis. After all eight of the troops are filled, a stand-by list of alternates will be established.

The 2010 National Scout Jamboree will use an online application process for all Scouts, leaders, and jamboree staff applicants desiring to attend the jamboree. This will be available in June 2008. The application process has two steps:

1. Complete an online application that is accessed through [www.MyScouting.org](http://www.MyScouting.org) (Event Registration page). You will need your BSA ID number (found on your registration card) to access the application Web site. The initial on-line application fee is \$10, nonrefundable and **does** apply to the council application fee.
2. You will be directed to print a confirmation and send it to the council with a \$100 deposit. You should complete the Council Application form, have it signed by a parent or guardian and signed by your Scoutmaster. Then send the confirmation, completed and signed application and the \$100 deposit to the Council office. Council Application forms can be picked up at the Council office or downloaded from:

Once leaders have been selected (early 2009), Scouts will have an opportunity to request to be placed in one of the eight troops.

## FEES

The Occoneechee Council Jamboree Committee will set the fees, payment schedule and establish the refund policy. The fee is expected to be \$1,295. The final cost will be determined and published by July 1, 2009. Transportation and equipment costs will determine the final amount. We do not anticipate the cost exceeding \$1,350.

The Jamboree fees cover all transportation, admission fees, meals and patrol and troop equipment, as well as insurance. Your fees also cover the pre-Jamboree training weekend. The only additional expense will be personal uniforms, personal equipment, money for lunch during the bus trip and spending money.

## TROOP ORGANIZATION
